Competitor Definitions



Age-Related Categories

Junior A & Junior B
Senior & Senior B
Masters

Junior B

Age 16 and under to December 31 2008 inclusive
Born 1992 or later
If you are turning 17 in 2008 you must row Junior

Junior A

Age 18 and under to December 31 2008 inclusive
Born 1990 or later
If you are turning 19 in 2008 you must row Senior B

Senior B

Age 22 and under to December 31 2008 inclusive
Born 1986 or later
If you are turning 23 in 2008 you must row Senior

Senior

Open to all ages

Recreational

Must not be affiliated with, or a member of, a club/high school/University/college rowing program.
Limited to recreational rowers e.g. health club members

Adaptive

Refer to the Adaptive Rowing Classifications used by Concept 2's On-Line Ranking system and select the statement that best applies to your disability as it applies to the sport of rowing.

Coxswain

Racing / training experience limited to role of coxswain having coxed a rowing race in a sanctioned regatta at least once during the 2007 regatta season. Cannot exceed the maximum coxswain weight as defined by the Lightweight category. There are no age restrictions.

Youth

Age 13 and under on race day. Age on race day determines race category.

University

Registered in a full-time program at a recognized Canadian or U.S. University or College.

Parent / Offspring

Must be legal guardian or biologically related as per categories listed. Any combination of father/son, mother/son, father/daughter, mother/daughter, or grandparent.

Lightweight

Male maximum weight of 165 lbs / 75 kg Female maximum weight of 135 lbs / 61 kg

Masters

Must be 30 years of age or older on race day. Age is on race day determines race category.

Medals will be awarded within 10 year age categories based on raw / un-handicapped scores in the Masters and Senior Masters Events. Medals will be awarded within 5-year age categories based on raw / un-handicapped scores in the Veteran Masters Events in both the open weight and lightweight divisions.
