CIRC RULES:

No one under the age of 14 may row in the CRASH-B Sprints or is eligible to win the trip. Anyone under the age of 18 years must have parental consent to accept the prize of the airfare. All 4 qualifiers who are selected to go must be eligible to race at the World's event. Refer to race and age eligibility rules on the CRASH-B website.

Lightweight Categories: Men - 165lbs / 75kg, Women 135lbs / 61.4kg See Concept 2 website for older age standards beyond age 79.

By CRASH-B rules, *Junior Event participants (age 14-18) must have been born on or after January 1, 1991 <u>AND</u> be enrolled in high school (or lower grade) as of race day (Feb 22, 2009).
